Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

Corpus Christi

The beginning of the tradition of celebrating Corpus Christi dates back to the 13th century. The real presence of Christ in the Eucharist Eucharistic processions on Corpus Christi were introduced later than the feast itself. The first trace of their existence is the mention of the solemn procession before the grand total in Cologne in the years 1265-75. During the procession, the cross with the Blessed Sacrament was carried. In this way, the old custom of taking the Eucharist for protection against dangers was referred to.

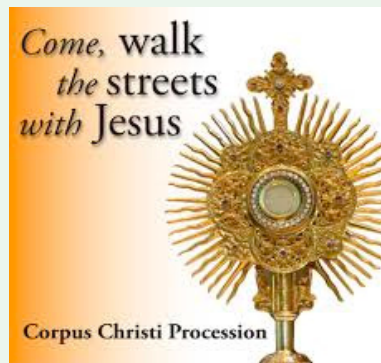




San Antonio de Padua
