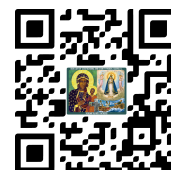

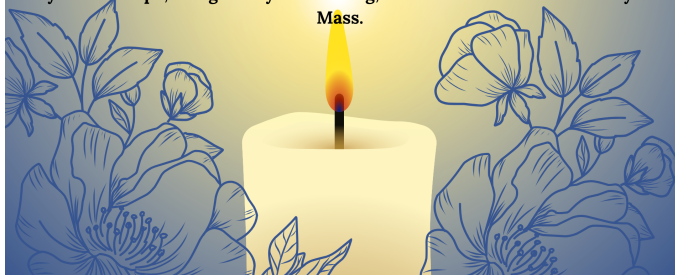

Saint Gerard Majella Redemptorist C.Ss.R.

The Patron Saint of Motherhood October 16



Saint Gerard Majella, the "Patron Saint of Motherhood," was born in 1726 in a small town in the south of Italy called Muro. Gerard was devoted to his widowed mother

and he also devoted his life to God and helping others. His selfless help to others in various circumstances endeared him to all sorts of people. He entered the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer in 1749 and became a lay brother. He was a model of obedience and possessed extraordinary wisdom. He spent his life dedicated to helping the needy and the poor, being poor himself and having an understanding of the sorrows of the needy. He often gave away his earnings and his own food to the poor and those that came to him never left empty-handed. Sometimes how the food or money came to be there was known only to God and to Gerard. He was also known to have mystical abilities such as powers of prophecy, healing, bi-location, the reading of consciences, and so forth. He even predicted the day and hour of his own death.

During his short life he helped many and performed many miracles. It seems that God had given him, in particular, the special power to help mothers in need. In life and since his death, he has helped so many women who have prayed to him during labor that he earned the nickname the "Saint of Happy Deliveries." Many mothers from all over the world have even named their child Gerard after him in gratitude, and have adopted him as their patron in the joys and fears of childbirth. Saint Gerard had a short stay here on earth dying in 1755 at the age of twenty-nine from tuberculosis, but he left a legacy of hope and faith to God that keeps spreading by word of mouth from those familiar with his life story and by those just discovering his miracles.

San Gerardo Majella Redentorista C.Ss.R.

El Santo Patrón de la Maternidad 16 de octubre



San Gerardo Majella, conocido como el “Santo Patrón de la Maternidad,” nació en 1726 en un pequeño pueblo del sur de Italia llamado Muro. Gerardo fue

muy devoto de su madre viuda y dedicó su vida a Dios y al servicio de los demás. Su ayuda desinteresada en distintas circunstancias le ganó el cariño de todo tipo de personas. En 1749 ingresó a la Congregación del Santísimo Redentor, donde se convirtió en hermano laico. Fue un modelo de obediencia y poseía una sabiduría extraordinaria. Dedicó su vida a ayudar a los necesitados y a los pobres, siendo él mismo pobre y comprendiendo el dolor de los que sufrían. A menudo regalaba sus ganancias y su propia comida a los necesitados, y nadie que acudía a él se iba con las manos vacías. A veces, sólo Dios y Gerardo sabían cómo llegaba el dinero o la comida. También se le conocía por tener dones místicos como la profecía, la sanación, la bilocación y la lectura de conciencias. Incluso predijo el día y la hora de su propia muerte.

Durante su corta vida, ayudó a muchos y realizó numerosos milagros. Parecía que Dios le había otorgado, en particular, un poder especial para ayudar a las madres necesitadas. En vida y después de su muerte, ha ayudado a muchas mujeres que le rezan durante el parto, por lo que se ganó el apodo de “Santo de los Buenos Partos.” Muchas madres de todo el mundo han nombrado a sus hijos Gerardo en agradecimiento y lo han adoptado como su santo patrono en las alegrías y temores de la maternidad. San Gerardo tuvo una vida breve, falleciendo en 1755 a la edad de veintinueve años a causa de la tuberculosis, pero dejó un legado de esperanza y fe en Dios que continúa extendiéndose de boca en boca, tanto por quienes conocieron su historia como por aquellos que recién descubren sus milagros.
